THE SUNFLOWER SHOW

The exhibition, featuring works created in September 2014 during a day-long Paint-Out at the Whitehall Farm field, as well as other pieces created in response to the annual blooms, will be held at The Yellow Springs Art Council Galley from Sept. 19–Oct. 11, 2015. A reception for the show will be from 2 to 4 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 27, at the Gallery. Artists may submit up to two pieces, and work will be for sale if an artist so chooses. Artwork must be received by noon Tuesday, Sept. 15, 2015.

Guidelines: Artists may submit one or two works created from the sunflower field at Whitehall Farm or inspired by sunflowers elsewhere. We will hang at least one work from each artist and attempt to hang all as space allows. No dimension shall exceed 5 feet.

Submission Guidelines: All entries must be framed and ready to hang with artist's name, title, date and dimensions labeled on back of work. Include a brief artist statement to accompany the submission, 300 words or less. Fill out the SUNFLOWER SHOW entry form and include with

submission. Please email 300 dpi jpeg image of each entry to sunflowers@tecumsehlandtrust.org for publicity purposes as early as possible before submission deadline. Drop off work Monday, Sept. 14, 2015, 6–9 p.m., or Tuesday, Sept. 15, 8 a.m.–noon at the Yellow Springs Arts Council Gallery, 111Corry St., Yellow Springs

Tecumseh Land Trust reserves the right to reproduce entries, for the sole purpose of publicizing the exhibition, use in press releases, slide shows, articles and on the TLT website. Artist credit will always accompany the artwork. The artist will retain all copyrights of any images submitted to **SUNFLOWER SHOW**.

Sales. Artwork that is for sale should include sales tax in the price; sales tax will not be added at time of sale. In the case of sales, 25% will go to benefit Tecumseh Land Trust, 25% will go to the Gallery commission, and 50% will go to the artist. Sales will be handled by a TLT representative. Artists will be notified of sales and will receive payment within 30 days of show closing date. All unsold work should be picked up at the Gallery from 4 to 8 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 11.

Insurance. YSAC and TLT will take every precaution with artwork for duration of show, but artists are responsible for insuring their own work.
