Truly a day to remember, The **Women's March**[13][14][15][a] was a worldwide protest on January 21, 2017, the day after the inauguration of President Donald Trump. It was prompted by the fact that several of Trump's statements were considered by many as anti-women or otherwise offensive to women.[13][19] It was the largest single-day protest in U.S. history.[20] The goal of the annual marches is to advocate legislation and policies regarding human rights and other issues, including women's rights, immigration reform, healthcare reform, disability justice, reproductive rights, the environment, LGBTQ rights, racial equality, freedom of religion,[21] workers' rights and tolerance. It was not without intent to feature bold, bright energetic intense colors intertwined with powerful symbols to support a unique beacon of light representing both individual human potential and the continuing quest for further enlightenment.

Raised with a foundation of both Roman Catholicism and Buddhism the artist offers this piece of advice to his fellow man.

"Open your mind, body and soul to honoring each and everyday to discover joy and/or try to create some to share with your fellow man. For the suffering will continue"

#5 LOVEPLAY

A colorful explosion of natural wonder and the human potential when celebrating life, love, music and the role of tribal rhythms celebrating "as one" societies prosper divided we fall. I must admit this piece directly inspired by one amazing night of music, love and hope with the band COLDPLAY at the Rose Bowl in Pasadena California. Finding ourselves center stadium equivalent of being on the 50 yard line for a football game we were surrounded by over 80,000 other fans Chris Martin and the band transcended us to another realm and it seemed we had been invited special to be in the center of a truly amazing night. The energy was palpable with every human being I passed by during the performance and after the show everyone seemed to have been anointed with a blessing of love, light and human potential for good.

#6 CIVIL WOLVES

This piece inspired GAJ for a creative call to action and the desire to present a serious minded "citizen fangs out" image in solidarity with a LA community led by Robert Kennedy Jr. Climate Movement Los Angeles at Banning Park in Wilmington a march to the Tesoro Refinery April 29th 2017 in solidarity with a march in Washington, D.C. and across the country to stand up for our communities and climate.

#7 DUAL DIVINITY

A tribute to two extraordinary musical artists their images and original symbols on full display the artist framing their gifts of musical genius set in an Picasso inspired framework.

#9 WIN LOSE OR DRAW

A right handed attempt to make sense of a tragedy in Las Vegas when 60 people were mercilessly gunned down 411 wounded as they gathered to listen to music. This event catapulted the the artist to title this as his "Hollow Ground" Series with an intension to help shed some glows of hopeful light on a darkened nation's mind set to maintain democracy.

Is it not the time to explore other vehicles and methods to secure, ensure and maintain this fragile balance of freedom we find ourselves in?

On the evening of October 1, 2017, Stephen Paddock, a 64-year-old man from Mesquite, Nevada, opened fire upon the crowd attending the Route 91 Harvest music festival on the Las Vegas Strip in Nevada. Between 10:05 and 10:15 p.m. PDT, he fired more than 1,000 rounds of ammunition from his 32nd floor suites in the Mandalay Bay Hotel, killing 60 people^[a] and wounding 411, with the ensuing panic bringing the injury total to 867. About an hour later, Paddock was found dead in his room from a self-inflicted gunshot wound. His motive remains officially undetermined.

The incident is the deadliest mass shooting committed by an individual in modern United States history. It focused attention on firearms laws in the U.S., particularly with regard to bump stocks, which Paddock used to fire shots in rapid succession, at a rate of fire similar to automatic weapons. [4] As a result, bump stocks were banned by the U.S. Justice Department in December 2018, with the regulation in effect as of March 2019.

#16 BLOOD LUST

Splattered across lives needing to blend hearts and experience pounding thunderous joyous rhythms with the potential at any moment to explore sharing cherished love.

If not for the beating hearts finding rhythmic beauty passionate and pure could such explosions potentially blast splatters of loving leftovers untamed and chaotic.

#17 PROPER MOURNING

2019 Dayton Shooting: On August 4, 2019, 24-year-old Connor Betts shot and killed nine people and injured 17 others near the entrance of the Ned Peppers Bar in the Oregon District of Dayton, Ohio. [3] Betts was fatally shot by responding police officers 32 seconds after the first shots were fired. [3][5] A total of 27 people were taken to area hospitals. [5] A search of the shooter's home found evidence that showed an interest in violence and mass shootings and that he had expressed a desire to commit one. Despite describing himself as a leftist and voicing his support for antifa, [6] a preliminary assessment did not indicate that Betts had a racial or political motive. [7] The attack occurred just 13 hours after a mass shooting in El Paso, Texas. [8]

#18 THREW THE DAY

This seemingly endless chaotic stream of this "Neon Orange" inspired piece takes the eye and the adventurous mind through a landscape filled with ups and downs, side to side, twists and turns and a sometimes no so pleasing ride. As in life, Sometimes you just don't have a choice but to just hang on to get "through the day."

#19 DIRTY \$GREEN\$ DISTRACTION

Dec 19th 2016 A most unfortunate memorable moment when the electoral college failed to fulfill it's primary duty and most vital role when accepting and qualifying Donald J Trump as capable in sound mind as the 45th president.

When inspiration strikes it is the responsibility of artists (modern day shamans) to act in kind and create imagery which permeates on to canvas.

As you circle clockwise down near the bottom you will see a body knocked flat which represents all the balance of people who count not have imagined such a day. The green glow surrounding the body's head is a glow dimmed, but not totally down and out representing hope for the future no less.

Just above the body positioned in a over arching half circle letters spell out the word "FREEDUMB" confusingly placed a planned so called message of distorted green.

Rounding up from bottom left to top left a coal burning 20th century factory is adorned with almost hidden lasting words of "trust me".

This painting was created within an 8-hour time period with the intention of the artist to depict feelings of utter disbelief using lines and shapes going in every direction to tell a story of just another "dirty green distraction." #21 LADY LIBERTY LICK

The artist's attempt to "time capsule capture" current and pending chaotic times to come when the amount of lies, corruption and foreign influence was on display apparent. The greed willing to tear a nation apart to the power play bending over our lady liberty nation for which it stands disregarding justice for all and to fuel already internal fires of dispute, racial inequality and social economic injustice.

#22 OWLS

WHERE "WHO" BELONGS SERIES

Who says there is not insightful wisdom hidden in the dark mysterious underworld of the conscious mind. A surely mysterious and supposedly wise ole' owl this cloaked savage killer never blinks once laying eyes on it's potential prey.

Truth be told never blink and is an opportunity to strike with purpose and commitment in the hunt for the truth, and a virtuous life including the light and the dark. To focus on a reality without doubt, without question, without a sense of mysterious ways. Powerful colors bold and bright setting the tone for a clear view in command of conscious being.
